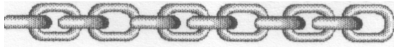
A gift of whatever you can afford will help save lives:

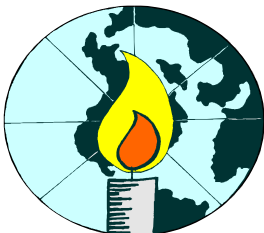
